

This list of requirements is designed to assist City of Galt Residents in properly filling your Handy Hauler.

Handy Haulers can only be filled with light materials, such as, but not limited to, brush, tree trimmings, household trash, cardboard and clothing. No dirt, concrete, rock, sod, brick or tile will be accepted in a Handy Hauler. No heavy construction debris can be accepted in our Handy Hauler. Handy Haulers must be level to the top and not overloaded.

The handy hauler will be emptied and then removed on the same day by two different trucks, so please do not refill the box in between as this will incur an additional full charge of the handy hauler fee for this service.

Acceptable Items

- Household trash
- Brush
- Tree trimmings
- Small furniture
- Extension cords
- Childrens toys
- Pieces of carpet and padding
- Toilets
- Bathroom or kitchen sink
- Mirrors
- Styrofoam
- Old or tattered clothing
- Not painted or treated wood

Unacceptable Items

- Dirt, concrete, rock, sod, brick, or tile
- Construction debris
- Televisions
- Auto batteries
- Tires
- E-Waste - Computers, monitors, printers, etc.
- Auto parts
- Dead animals
- Appliances - Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc.
- Liquids
- Paint
- Antifreeze
- Petroleum products
- Hazardous/Toxic waste/Waste containing mercury
- Pesticides
- Drum containers over 1 gallon in size
- Infectious/Medical waste
- Treated wood
