- · Peels and rinds
- Breads and pasta
- · Meat, poultry, and fish
- Shellfish shells
- · Rice, oats, and grains
- Food soiled paper

bags ARE ACCEPTED to collect food waste.

All other bags are contamination (see below).





NOT ACCEPTED

- · Plastic bags (white, black, tan, blue, yellow, or any other color)
- Straws or wrappers

- · Plastic food packaging of any kind
- Plastic utensils
