These items belong in your trash container.

- Household waste
- Plastic film
- Ceramic dishware
- Mirrors and tempered glass
- Padded envelopes
- Photographs
- Plastic bags
- Sponges
- Toothpaste tubes
- Bubble wrap/Styrofoam
- Tarps, shower curtains
- Any kind of tape
- Straws
- Wax paper cups



NOT ACCEPTED

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Items classified as HHW must be brought to the nearest HHW collection site to be disposed of. Visit your county's website to find a convenient HHW collection site.

- Batteries
- Light bulbs
- Paint
- Aerosols



- Medical waste
- Oils or cleaning liquids
- Thick gauge metal



ACCEPTED FOOD WASTE

These items can go in your food waste container.

- Produce scraps
- Egg shells
- Bones
- Dairy products
- Peels and rinds
- Breads and pasta
- Meat, poultry, and fish
- Shellfish shells
- Rice, oats, and grains
- Food soiled paper

ONLY CLEAR plastic bags ARE ACCEPTED to collect food waste. All other bags are contamination (see below).



NOT ACCEPTED

These items **CANNOT** go in your food waste container.

- Plastic bags (white, black, tan, blue, yellow, or any other color)
- Straws or wrappers
- Plastic food packaging of any kind
- Plastic utensils



RECYCLE

These items belong in your recycle container.

- Newspaper
- Paper bags
- Cardboard
- Magazines and catalogs
- Cereal boxes
- Beverage containers
- Condiment containers
- Detergent containers
- Clear take out containers
- Buckets
- Glass bottles and jars
- Cans
- Metal bottle caps and lids
- Metal pots and pans
- Clean aluminum foil



NOT ACCEPTED

- Trash
- Hazardous waste
- Food waste
- Plastic bags
- Light bulbs
- Batteries
- Aerosol cans
- Soiled paper and packaging
