WOODBRIDGE CLEANUP

MONDAY - APRIL 14, 2025 All Materials Must Be At The Curb By 6:00 AM.

4 cu. yds. - Max Accepted



7ft LONG

- You may place up to FOUR (4) cubic yards of material at the curb.
- · Accepted items: furniture, carpet, mattresses, clothing (that is beyond a state of reusing or recycling), and electronics.
- · Leaves, lawn clippings, and prunings of vegetation must be bagged or placed in a box or container.
- · Boxes and bins containing loose items must not be larger than 4' x 4' x 2' OR exceed 50 pounds.
- Tree trunks and branches cannot exceed 2" in diameter and 5' in legth and must be in bundles that do not exceed 50 pounds.

Appliances containing Freon, such as refrigerators and freezers, **must be scheduled prior** to April 10th by calling Cal-Waste Customer Service Representatives at 209-369-6887.

Household Hazardous Waste Will Not Be Accepted.



Paints, pesticides, household hazardous waste (HHW), tires, or oils will NOT be accepted at this event.

All HHW must be brought to San Joaquin County's HHW Consolidation Facility. 7850 R.A. Bridgeford Street, Stockton, CA.

Call Ahead for Appliances That Have Freon.



Refrigerators, freezers, and other appliances that require the CERTIFIED evacuation of freon may only be included in pickups if the resident calls Cal-Waste prior to collection and agrees to pay the \$54.08 per unit removal charge.
